Code of Conduct

Sky Surfing Club (SSC) is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

While engaging in any activities promoted by the club, including hang gliding, paragliding and paramotoring related activities, SSC meetings or when representing the SSC in club sponsored competition, as a member of the SSC you must:

- Respect the dignity and worth of the general public and other members, regardless of ability, age, race, gender, disability, religion or belief, sexual orientation, etc.
- Not bully, harass, swear at, endanger, or commit acts of violence towards the general public and other members
- Be polite and defer to members of the public at all times. Take time to engage with those who show an interest and ask questions.
- Follow the social media policy of the club
- Follow the site rules as described in club's handbook and on the club's website.
- When visiting sites belonging to other clubs, the rules of that club and their site guide must be followed
- Respect the rights of all pilots to fly. Don't "hog the air" when sites are crowded and other pilots wish to fly
- Follow the rules laid down by the BHPA and air law / rules of the air
- Not bring the club into disrepute.

The Committee may warn or expel any Member who fails to follow this Code of Conduct
