



Code of Conduct

Sky Surfing Club (SSC) is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

While engaging in paragliding & paragliding related activities on SSC controlled sites, SSC meetings or when representing SSC in club sponsored competition, as a member of SSC you must:

- Follow SSC Site rules as described in the club handbook and on the club website
- Respect the dignity and worth of other members, regardless of ability, age, race, sex, gender reassignment, disability, religion or belief, sexual orientation, marriage or civil partnership, pregnancy or maternity
- Not bully, harass, endanger, or commit acts of violence towards other members.
- Follow the rules laid down by the BHPA
- Not bring the club into disrepute

The Committee may warn or expel any Member who fails to follow this Code of Conduct.
